April 21st – Saturday – Free day - Savannah Theatre (evening)





Free day to enjoy Savannah and in the evening you will enjoy this historic Theatre.

The talented Savannah Theatre cast puts on an array of performances throughout the year full of energy and great tunes. Current, past and upcoming performances have included Jukebox Journey, which features hit songs from the 1940s to 70s; Savannah Live, a variety show with pop, Broadway, Motown and rock music; The Beat Goes On, with music from the 1960s, 70s and 80s; and Christmas Tradition, a glitzy holiday performance with Christmas standards. The building that houses the theatre, the Historic Savannah Theatre, is steeped in history. The theatre, which considers itself the oldest in America, first opened its doors in 1818 and has undergone several renovations over the years.
